

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the Dominion of Canada on November 22nd of 1897, "**Queen Victoria - Maple Leaf**" 6 cents brown, perforated 12, on medium white wove paper without watermark, Scott Catalogue #71, unused, a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 125% of true size, and am of the opinion that:

The stamp submitted is **genuine in all respects**, unused, with full original gum, **never hinged**, with fresh and bright colour, and is entirely free from faults or repairs at the time of examination. All relevant factors taken into account, it has a quality rating of **XF-Superb - 95 - OGnh**.
